**NOTICE OF NEW FOREST DISTRICT (OUTSIDE THE NATIONAL PARK) CORE
STRATEGY ADOPTION STATEMENT**

In accordance with Regulation 24(2) and Regulation 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2008, notice is hereby given that New Forest District Council adopted the Core Strategy for New Forest District (outside the National Park) as a Development Plan Document on 26th October 2009. The Core Strategy is the principal document of the Local Development Framework and sets out the vision, objectives, spatial development strategy and overarching policies that will guide the development in New Forest District (outside the National Park) to 2026.

Michael Hetherington, an Independent Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government considered the Core Strategy at an Examination in Public held between 27th February 2009 and 10th September 2009. The Inspector's Report, with its recommendations, was published on 10th September 2009. The adopted Core Strategy contains the Inspector's recommendations that are binding on the Council.

Any person aggrieved by the Core Strategy DPD may make an application under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 to the High Court on grounds that the document is not within the appropriate powers and/or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any such application must be made by no later than the end of the period of six weeks from the date of the adoption of this Core Strategy (i.e. by 7th December 2009).
